Your rights as a data subject

- Accuracy: Data must be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date.
- Storage limitation: Data must be kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed.
- Integrity and confidentiality: Data must be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, using appropriate technical or organizational measures.
- Accountability: The Data Controller is responsible for, and must be able to demonstrate, compliance with these principles.

Data Retention

We will not retain any information longer than is necessary to provide the services we offer to you.

Legal basis for the data processing

The legal basis for collecting data subject data is the necessity for the performance of a service to you, compliance with a legal obligation (such as the GDPR), and the legitimate interests in offering the services that Lean on Me offer, and in providing and improving our services.

Data Security

We take reasonable measures to protect any personal information we may hold in order to prevent loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. Personal Information shall be protected by security safeguards appropriate to the sensitivity of the information.
